Several years later, they decided to form a Rose Croix Chapter, and thus in 1985 the Shirley Woolmer Chapter No. 948 was Consecrated. The Chapter flourished, but over the years, the number of S.W. Lodge members, despite invitation, has reduced to zero. The membership now derives from a number of Lodges around West Kent, and is very well attended, and produces a very high standard of ritual, with a very friendly environment, attracting many visitors. Despite the lack of a Col we have benefited from committed Sovereigns who have delivered excellent ceremonies.
