## GENERAL INFORMATION

<b>CHAPTER HISTORY</b>	<p>The Warrant for the formation of Westwood Chapter No 764 was granted on the 27th June 1974 after 18 like-minded brethren partitioned to become the Founders of the Chapter. Several of the Founders were members of the East Kent Provincial Grand Stewards' Lodge, the West Kent Provincial Grand Stewards' Lodge and the West Kent First Principals' Chapter. The Consecration meeting took place at 10 Duke Street on the 1st October 1974, at which 9 members of the Supreme Council 33° attended and officiated, assisted by the Grand Director of Ceremonies, an Assistant Grand Director of Ceremonies, the Grand Organist and the Grand Outer Guard (and we have a copy of the Consecration Summons within the archives for the Chapter). During its 50th anniversary year, on the 8th July 2024, Westwood Chapter was honoured to be the Host Chapter for the Installation Ceremony of one of its own members as he was installed as the new Inspector General for the District of West Kent. Over the many years since the Consecration, Westwood Chapter has, and continues to attract members from all backgrounds, in particular drawing on its many links within the District.</p>

<b>LIST</b>	The current Inspector General for the District of West Kent is a member, having been a member since 1998. The current District Recorder is a Honorary Member. The Past Inspector General and the Past District Recorder are both Honorary members of the Chapter. The Chapter is currently enjoying its 50th year (being consecrated in 1974). The Chapter hosted the Installation ceremony for the new Inspector General on the 8th July 2024 at Oakley House, Bromley, where members of the Supreme Council and over 130 members of the District attended. We believe we hold the record for the youngest Most Wise Sovereign in the District of West Kent at 26 years, 10 months and 20 days old (18.11.2022) and 'ergo' the youngest 30° Freemason in West Kent at 28 years, 4 months and 22 days old (21.05.2024), which is a testament to the support that our members receive.

## OVERALL SUMMARY ABOUT THE CHAPTER

An incredibly friendly and personable Chapter with a wide age group range including members in their 20s, 30s, 40s, 50s, 60s, 70s and one member in his 80s. Excellent standard of ritual with a passion for inclusivity so all members have the opportunity to undertake a part of the ceremony should they so desire. Well established Chapter with a healthy candidate pipeline. Full of professional individuals from a variety of backgrounds including; building trade, service industry, fire & security, armed forces members (active & veterans) and members of the emergency services viz., Police, Fire Brigade, Ambulance & Coast Guard. We meet at the Oakley House Masonic Centre, Bromley Common, Bromley, Kent BR2 8HA and our meetings generally start at 5pm (traffic dependent) with the Festive Board usually finishes around 8.30pm/9pm (if not before). The festive board cost at Bromley is taken from the Silver Menu, which is £32, consisting of a 3 course meal. All meals are served with; bread & butter, the Chef's choice of vegetables & potatoes, and finishing with Tea or Coffee. Attire at our meetings is as per a Masonic meeting, i.e. dark lounge suit, or Morning Dress, however your tie can be brightly coloured (some members wear a blue and white polka dot tie, which can be obtained online). You will also require an 18° collar and jewel for the 18° ceremony but this is the only regalia you will need for the meeting (no gloves).
