Rail

Train services

Cambridge main line railway station is on the outskirts of the city centre. Queens' College is a short taxi ride from the station. Alternatively it is a 12 minute walk from the station to the Cambridge Masonic Centre in Bateman Street from where a free shuttle service will run to Queens' College. See below for details of the shuttle service.

Bus Services

Drummer Street bus station is situated in the centre of Cambridge and is a 15 minute walk from Queens' College.

Park and Ride

City Centre parking is generally short term and quite expensive. There are five Park and Ride car parks on the outskirts of the city, these are located at Madingley Road, Milton, Trumpington, Babraham Road and Newmarket Road.

A bus service operates between each site and the city centre bus station in Drummer Street/Parker Street. The bus from the Trumpington site travels down Trumpington Street and gives the nearest access to Queens' College. The Park and Ride service is designed for shoppers and regrettably the last buses depart from Drummer Street before our scheduled finish time of 8.30pm. However, it is still possible to gain access to and drive out of the Park and Ride sites after the bus service has ended. You may consider it worthwhile using this facility and returning to the site by taxi

Car Parking

We are unable to offer any parking at Queens' College. Limited parking will be available at the Cambridge Masonic Centre in Bateman Street. It is a pleasant 15 minute walk from Bateman Street to Queens' College through the historic streets of Cambridge.

Cambridge is not a car friendly city and you are advised to share transport wherever possible.

Refreshment

The Bar at Queens College will be open from 1 30pm and provide for sale coffee and tea.

The city centre is a 15 minute walk from Bateman Street (in the same direction as Queens' College) where there are numerous cafes, bars, restaurants and public houses.

We hope you will enjoy the event and your time in Cambridge.

Route from the Bus Station

Queens' is within walking distance of the Cambridge bus/coach station at Drummer Street. Many bus and coach services run from there. Buses from Drummer Street go direct to the railway station.
